Objectives of the Village Hall Management Committee in 2023

The Village Hall in Maplebeck is primarily for the use of the communities of Maplebeck, Winkburn and Kersall and its objectives are to provide 'forms of recreation and leisure-time occupation' for the inhabitants of those communities¹. The Committee members, who are also trustees of the charity, are elected by the residents of Maplebeck to run the Village Hall. Committee members can also be coopted onto the Committee

In March 2023, Roger Bell joined the Committee which included Donna Crow, Max Crow, Rachel Gardner and Julie Grundy.

Financial Review

The accounts of the Village Hall have been independently reviewed and the financial statement is included. In 2023, the Village Hall's income exceeded expenditure by £861. This was particularly pleasing given the rising costs of running the hall and the major expenditure that was needed to ensure that we continue to meet current Health and Safety Standards.

This is a testament not just to the hard work of the committee in organising events but also to the community for supporting us at the Quiz in February, the fete in June and the Ceilidh in October. The Scarecrow competition, although not specifically to raise money, provided lots of entertainment to villagers and those who attended the fete and our thanks to everyone who took up the challenge.
